Welcome to the Haworth After School Enrichment Program Winter 2012 catalogue. We are committed to bringing a varied program to all of our children.

Important Reminders

**School Nurse** – Please be aware the School Nurse is unavailable during the After School Enrichment Programs. If your child has health issues which require medication, a parent will have to be in attendance to administer any medication.

**Snacks** – Because so many students in the After School Enrichment Programs have severe allergies to a wide variety of foods, NO SNACKS MAY BE BROUGHT TO ENRICHMENT CLASSES.

**Pick Up** – All classes begin at 3:05 pm and end at 4:00 pm. Students are to be promptly picked up from the classroom at 4:00 pm, not the Multi-Purpose Room. The parents should enter and be buzzed in via the front door (not the Multi Purpose Room). **The After School Enrichment Program staff is not responsible for supervising children not promptly claimed after Enrichment classes unless your child is currently enrolled in the After School Program. Any child picked up late more than once per session will be removed from the program with no refund.**

Enrollment Information

**Admissions** – The After School Enrichment Program is brought to you by the HHSA. We encourage all families to be members. Membership forms are available on [www.hhsa.info](http://www.hhsa.info). Children must be in the grade level designated for the desired course. **Class sizes are limited and classes are filled on a first-come, first served basis.** Classes are subject to cancellation due to insufficient enrollment. **Registration is from Monday, January 9 through Tuesday, January 17.**

**Tuition** – All tuition is payable in full at registration, either by cash or check\*. **Make checks payable to: Haworth Home and School Association, Inc.** \* - A \$35 fee will be incurred for any checks returned.

**Refunds** – **Refunds will only be made if a class is cancelled due to insufficient enrollment.** Choose your classes carefully since there will be no other opportunity for a refund. *No refunds will be given for student illness, student withdrawal for personal reason, expulsion due to behavior problems, or class cancellation due to inclement weather.*

**Classes Begin** – **Classes will begin on Monday January 23<sup>rd</sup>.** Please see the noted dates on each class as each class has a different number of sessions and are priced accordingly. Please make sure to read the class descriptions for any exceptions or qualifications.

**School Closing** – There will be no classes on scheduled holidays, half days or days on which school has been closed because of inclement weather.

**Discipline** – To be successful, the After School Enrichment Program needs to provide all participating students with a safe and pleasant environment. Accordingly, the Enrichment Committee reserves the right to remove a child from any class, on a temporary or permanent basis, for behavior that the instructor or the Committee determines to be inappropriate or destructive.
